Applicate Requirements

- Must be attending a college or vocational school in the year the scholarship is awarded.
- Must be a Gahr PTSA member.
- Unofficial Gahr Transcript

Personal Statement Guidelines

- 2-3 pages, 12 point, double spaced
- Do not mention your name or your parents names in the statement
- Answer the following questions:
 1. What are your educational and career goals? Describe your most meaningful achievements and how they relate to your field of study and your future goals.
 2. Who or what has inspired you to pursue your college education?
 3. From a financial standpoint, how would this scholarship help you to achieve your educational goals.
